



WAIVER AND PERMISSION FORM

Summary of Event: Mountaintop Faith Ministries (MFM) is hosting an event for teenage girls during its Women’s Empowerment Group Conference in August 2019. The event will cover topics that impact teenage girls self-esteem and can include, but may not be limited to, sex, masturbation, family dynamics, relationships (friendships/parents/siblings/relatives), suicidal thoughts, mental health issues, sex trafficking, domestic violence, bullying, and other issues relevant to them. The event will be recorded and pictures will be taken.

Waiver of Liability: By signing below, you are giving your daughter permission to attend this event and acknowledge that the above topics may be discussed. You also acknowledge that your child may divulge information that you consider confidential or private or may require MFM to report to the appropriate authorities, including the metropolitan police department and child protective services. Additionally, by signing below, you are agreeing to release MFM from any and all responsibility, liability, damages, and causes of action, of any kind, resulting from or related to your daughter’s participation in the event.

Permission to Record, Photograph and/or use Child’s Picture: Also, by signing below, you are agreeing to your child/ren being recorded and/or having pictures taken of them. You understand that MFM may use the recording or pictures to market, advertise, promote, or publicize the WEG Conference or any portion thereof. By signing below, you give MFM permission to use your child’s name, picture, and/or likeness.

Definitions: MFM includes, but is not limited to, the corporation/church itself and its Senior Pastor, Board of Directors, officers, employees, ministers/elders, volunteers and the like. Daughter includes your biological child and any child to whom you are a guardian or to whom you have custody.

Miscellaneous Legal Provisions

This Waiver and Permission form shall bind your heirs, representatives, estate, and the like.

In the event that any one or more of the terms, provisions, covenants, or restrictions of this Waiver and Permission form are determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of the terms, provisions, covenants, and restrictions shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated. Rather, the part of the Waiver and Permission form found to be invalid or unenforceable will be amended, changed, or interpreted to achieve as nearly as possible the same objectives and economic effect as the original provision, or replaced to the extent possible, with a legal, enforceable, and valid provision that is as similar in tenor to the stricken provision, within the limits of applicable law or applicable court decisions, and the remainder of the form will remain in full force.

This Waiver and Permission form may be executed in one or more counterparts, including without limitation, a counterpart bearing a facsimile or e-mail signature, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which together shall constitute a single instrument.

This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether written or verbal, with respect to its subject matter.

In the event of a dispute between the parties regarding any matter set forth herein, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

This Waiver and Permission form shall be construed under the laws of the State of Nevada and venue shall be proper in the city of Las Vegas, County of Clark.

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
